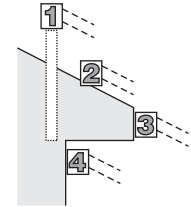
4. How Wide Will The Roof Panels Be?

Four Foot (47¼" Panels / 48" Centers) Two Foot (23½" Panels / 24¼" Centers)

5. Where Will Your Cover Attach?

- 1 Above The Roof / Elevated Hanger
 - SkyLift Roof Riser Hardware
 - Conventional Post with Shoes & Bracket
- 2 Beam Brackets Directly On The Roof
- 3 Fascia (Overhang) - May Require Removal of Existing Gutter
- 4 Against The House Wall - Siding, Stucco, Brick, Etc.
- 5 Free-Standing Additional Posts and Beams Will Be Included
